VACANCY NOTIFICATION

The National e-Governance Division (NeGD), under the Digital India Corporation (DIC), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, has been established to support the Programme Management, implementation, and monitoring of the Digital India Programme and e-Governance initiatives of the Government of India. NeGD works in close coordination with Central Ministries, State Governments, and other stakeholders for the conceptualization, design, development, and implementation of national digital platforms, portals, and technology-enabled governance systems. In addition, NeGD provides support in the areas of policy formulation, project appraisal, capacity building, technical advisory, and monitoring of mission-mode programmes, thereby contributing to the realization of the vision of a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.

2. NeGD invites applications for the following positions from amongst candidates appeared in the Interview of Civil Services Examination (CSE) from 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025 conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC). Details of the post is as under :

4. There are two functional domains for which candidates shall be selected. In addition to the UPSC Interview eligibility, candidates must meet the domain-specific education and experience criteria listed in the following table:

Candidates may indicate their preferred functional domain (Programme Management / Technology Management) in the application form based on their educational background and professional experience. The domain preference expressed by the candidate shall be purely indicative and non-binding **and shall not** confer any right or priority in shortlisting, selection, or final placement. The final decision regarding suitability, placement, and engagement including assignment of domain, role, and responsibilities shall rest with NeGD, based on eligibility criteria, experience, project requirements, and other relevant factors, as assessed by the competent authority.

5. **Method of Recruitment:**

I. **Selection Process**

- i. **Shortlisting of candidate:** Merit list will be prepared considering marks obtained by the candidate in the Civil Service Examination (candidates who appeared more than one year may submit with application email any one of the consolidated marksheet, which cannot be changed later at any stage). The shortlisting process will also consider the functional requirements, project needs, and operational priorities of National e-Governance Division (NeGD), ensuring that only the most suitable and relevant profiles are considered for further evaluation.
- ii. Candidates will be called for interviews in 1:5 ratio based on the final marks secured in UPSC exam for the year 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025 along with the functional requirements, project needs, and operational priorities of National e-Governance Division (NeGD).
- iii. Candidates who are working in Central/State Government/PSUs/ Autonomous/Statutory Organizations have to produce a No objection certificate from their employer at the time of the interview.

II. **Selection:** List will be prepared based on the following criteria:

- 60% weightage for consolidated marks secured in UPSC (Main) Examination. UPSC marks for the purpose of this recruitment shall mean the total marks obtained in the Civil Services Examination (CSE) (Mains + Personality Test) as declared by UPSC for the relevant year.
- 40% weightage for Interview of NeGD to assess the candidate's understanding of the subject.
- The shortlisted candidate shall be called for interview at New Delhi.
- The domain-wise qualifications indicate the broad suitability criteria for deployment and assignment. These do not create a right to appointment in any specific domain.

6. **Nature of engagement:**

- **Contract Period :** (04) years, or project duration whichever is earlier. The contract shall be extendable as per project requirement.
- **Probation:** The successful candidates recruited shall undergo probation of 06 Months and their further continuation in the project would be subject to the satisfactory completion of the probation period.

- **Pay & Allowances:** The selected candidates shall be entitled to consolidated pay as given below in addition to facilities like Laptop, Medical Benefits, PF, Gratuity and any other allowance over and above as applicable.

- **Post:** Candidates with 2–5 years of post-qualification experience may be considered for appointment as Asst. General Manager (AGM), while candidates with more than 5 years of post-qualification experience may be considered for appointment as Deputy General Manager, subject to assessment during the selection process.
- Increments shall be performance-linked, based on achievement of assigned KRAs/KPIs, annual appraisal ratings, and demonstrated ability to take on higher responsibilities
- These engagements are purely contractual and project-based in nature and do not constitute appointments to any civil post or service.
- The Place of posting will be New Delhi.

7. How to apply:

7.1 The candidate has to apply in the prescribed format (attached with this notification as Annexure A) and send the application to the email id negdhr@digitalindia.gov.in. Applications not in the prescribed format, are liable to be rejected.

7.2 The e-mail ID entered in the application form should remain active until the recruitment process is completed. No change in the e-mail ID will be allowed once entered.

7.3 Candidates may indicate their preferred functional domain (Programme Management / Technology Management) in the application form based on their educational background and professional experience. The domain preference expressed by the candidate shall be purely indicative and non-binding **and shall not** confer any right or priority in shortlisting, selection, or final placement. The final assignment of domain, role, and responsibilities shall be determined by NeGD based on organizational requirements, suitability assessed during the selection process, and overall merit, and may differ from the preference indicated by the candidate.

8. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- I. Only **Indian Nationals** are eligible to apply.
- II. UPSC marks for the purpose of this recruitment shall mean the total marks obtained in the Civil Services Examination (CSE) Mains + Personality Test) as declared by UPSC for the relevant year.
- III. The domain-wise qualifications indicate the broad suitability criteria for deployment and assignment. These do not create a right to appointment in any specific domain.
- IV. Applications which are incomplete or received after the prescribed date will not be considered.
- V. NeGD reserves the right to modify the selection procedure, if deemed fit.
- VI. Engagement shall be **purely contractual** and shall not confer any right for regular appointments.
- VII. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
- VIII. Candidates should satisfy themselves about their eligibility for the post applied for. NeGD shall determine their eligibility only at the final stage, i.e. while calling them for interview.
- IX. NeGD reserves the right to raise the minimum standards in respect of qualification and experience in order to restrict the number of candidates to be called for the Interview. Thus, merely fulfilling the eligibility conditions laid down in the advertisement as regards qualifications and experience, would not automatically entitle any candidate to be called for the Interview.
- X. NeGD reserves the right to modify/alter/restrict/enlarge/cancel the recruitment process, if need so arises without issuing any further notice or assigning any reasons thereafter. The decision of the NeGD will be final and no appeal will be entertained against this issue.
- XI. If the candidates are not eligible or have knowingly or willfully furnished incorrect or false particulars or suppressed material information, their candidature will be liable to be cancelled at any stage of the selection. If the candidate qualifies in the selection process and subsequently it is found that he/she does not fulfill the eligibility criteria, his/her candidature will be cancelled and if appointed, his/her services would be terminated without any notice or compensation.
- XII. Decision of NeGD in all matters regarding eligibility, selection and posting would be final and binding on all candidates. No representation or correspondence will be entertained by NeGD in this regard.
- XIII. In case of any disputes, jurisdiction of courts shall be at New Delhi.

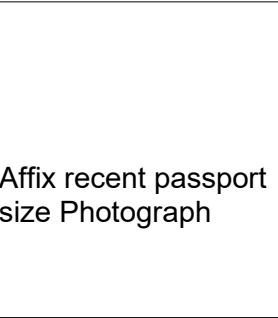
